



Re: 30th Annual Miracle Ride for Riley Kids is Saturday AND Sunday, June 1-2, 2024

Dear Miracle Ride Supporter,

Hello! I want to thank you for your past support for the annual Miracle Ride. Due to your commitment to helping us help Riley heal their sick kids, *the Miracle Ride Foundation has surpassed the \$7 million dollar milestone in donations to Riley Children's Foundation!*

In 2022, we donated a total of \$96,330 to the Riley Children's Foundation. The Riley Children's Foundation recommended that we create a Miracle Ride Endowment Fund and we agreed. The Miracle Ride Endowment Fund will pay dividends to Riley Hospital for Children from now to eternity. At the beginning of this year, we added more money to make it an even \$100,000. The Endowment Fund is now generating interest, which will add an additional minimum of \$5,000 to whatever we generate for next year.

We anticipate being able to donate another \$50,000 in 2023, which will increase the overall total in the Miracle Ride Endowment Fund to \$150,000 by year-end. We aim to generate an additional \$100,000 in next year's Miracle Ride, which will increase the Miracle Ride Endowment Fund to a quarter of a million dollars. Again, this fund will continue to generate interest, which will be given directly to Riley Children's Foundation till the end of time.

The year 2024 will be the Miracle Ride's 30th anniversary and Riley Hospital for Children's 100th anniversary. So, we want to make it a huge event! The Miracle Ride Board of Directors has decided that our 30th anniversary will be the last Miracle Ride as we know it. The Miracle Ride Board of Directors has also decided to "go all out" and make next year's ride an event to remember. Therefore, we are going back to a two-day schedule with the Poker Runs being held on Saturday, June 1st and the "Big Ride" where we ride past Riley Hospital for Children will be on Sunday, June 2nd. This will be a Police Escorted ride as we had in the past!

The Miracle Ride Foundation will continue after our 30th anniversary but in a smaller capacity. For example, Indianapolis Southside Harley-Davidson and Benson Motorcycles will continue to hold an annual Miracle Ride Poker Run and the proceeds will go into the Miracle Ride Endowment Fund. Our hope is that other dealerships will do the same. Plus, people can even add the Miracle Ride Endowment Fund to their Will if they wish. I will continue to manage and maintain the Miracle Ride Foundation's website, Facebook page, and other social media sites where we will continue to support the companies and dealerships who support us.

For the Miracle Ride's 30th anniversary and Riley's 100th anniversary, it is imperative that we receive support from you to make it an event to remember.

Kids in Crisis

The American Academy of Pediatrics declared children's mental health a national emergency. This need is particularly striking close to home. Indiana is in the bottom 20 percent of states in availability of child psychiatrists and the top half of status in terms of youth suicide rates.

Leslie Hulvershom, M.D., is the director of child and adolescent psychiatry at Riley Children's Health and chair of the Department of Psychiatry at Indiana University School of Medicine. She stated that Riley Hospital for Children is championing the statewide response to this crisis and emphasized the crucial role that donors serve in shaping a brighter future for Hoosier kids.

Introducing Dylan and Michelle Murphy and their son, Bryce, who is a Riley Kid 2024 Ambassador Family

Reason for my Riley treatment:

When Bryce was born, he was initially diagnosed with VACTERL association. VACTERL represents an acronym for a broad spectrum of congenital birth anomalies. V (vertebral anomaly), A (anal atresia), C (cardiac anomaly), T & E (tracheoesophageal fistula), R (rental anomaly), and L (limb anomaly). As time went on, Bryce would later be diagnosed with oculo-auriculo-vertebral spectrum (OAV), also known as Goldenhar Syndrome. Bryce was born with severe congenital scoliosis and rib abnormalities, imperforate anus, tetralogy of Fallot, unilateral microtia, hemifacial microsomia, hydronephrosis, lambdoid craniosynostosis, and hypoxic-ischemic encephalopathy (HIE). On day 3 of life, Bryce underwent his first surgery with Dr. Barrett Cromeens for his imperforate anus. Since then, Bryce has had six other surgeries and multiple other procedures in the Riley OR. Bryce has undergone two open-heart surgeries with Dr. Mark Turrentine and a series of neurosurgeries with Dr. Laurie Ackerman and Dr. Sunil Tholpady.

Bryce spent the first four months of his life at Riley between the NICU and CVICU. Bryce would continue to have many more admittances due to severe feeding intolerance and standard illnesses that would otherwise not affect a child, but due to his weakened immune system and heart condition, Bryce would require significant support.

Bryce visits Riley multiple times per month for appointments with his 16 Riley physicians and other outpatient clinics.

Why we love Riley:

First and foremost, Riley saved our child's life. Riley's phenomenal doctors and surgeons made a miracle for our family. While we have an excellent support system of family and friends, Riley has been our main source of support. Riley has educated us on all aspects of our child's medical diagnoses and needs. Riley has provided us with services to help us cope with our grief during the most challenging time in our lives. Riley's doctors, nurses, and staff have continued to grow relationships with our family, bringing us comfort during our inpatient and outpatient visits. They have advocated for our family when we didn't know how. Riley has become a large part of the Murphy family, and we are forever grateful. Our family will continue to do whatever we can to give back to Riley for all they have done for us.
