WHAT: The [Miracle Ride](#) is the state of Indiana's largest and longest running motorcycle charity event and among the largest and most impactful nationwide.

WHEN: Sunday, June 3, 2018 is the day of "The Big Ride" when Miracle Riders honor the kids, their families and the work of the Riley caregivers. This is the 25th year.

STARTING ADDRESS: The Big Ride stages at the Allison Transmission plant south parking lot (Cossell Road south off W. 10th Street). Allison Transmission is located at One Allison Way, Indianapolis, IN 46222-3271.

ROUTE: The police escort and first rider leaves Allison Transmission at 11am sharp. They will arrive at Riley Hospital for Children around 11:10 am and at the gate into Indianapolis Motor Speedway at approximately 11:20 am. The last rider in the procession will leave Allison approximately 11:45 am, Riley Hospital for Children at 12 noon, IMS at 12:15 pm and 8 Seconds Saloon lot at 12:30 pm. The window is approximately 11 am to 12:30 pm depending on the number of participants.

END ADDRESS: 143 Lynhurst Dr. (8 Seconds Saloon parking lot)

FACTS:

- 2018 participant donation \$50 per rider, \$50 for passengers age 16 and up, Age 8-15 \$25. Under age 8 free.
- 2017 number of participants: 3,200 AND 2017 donation to Riley Hospital: \$300,000
- 2018 Miracle Ride goal: \$350,000
- Total amount donated from all Miracle Ride events since 1994: \$6,200,000 making the Miracle Ride Riley Hospital's largest independent fund-raising donor.
